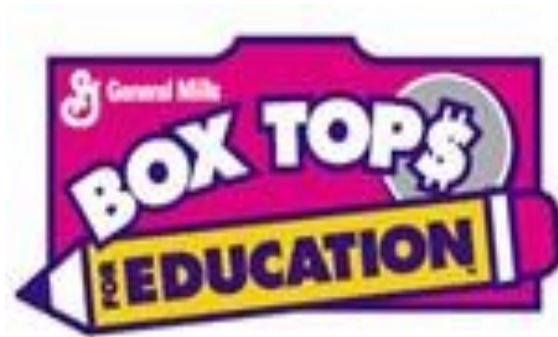

Attention Everyone,

It is a good idea for all of us to be informed with regard to the flu season. This flu is not one of the strains that the flu vaccine protects against. There are also different strains of viruses that cannot be treated with antibiotics; they can only treat the symptoms. Here in the nurse's office, I am seeing headaches, chills, fever, stomach issues, and cold symptoms that result in bronchitis.

As a result, I am writing to remind you all of the importance of disinfecting exposed surfaces such as

****Door knobs***

****Desks***

Good Hand Washing Techniques need practiced by ALL, especially after bathroom use and before and after eating.

All toys, balls, stuffed animals, and favorite pillows need to be sprayed with a non-hazardous disinfectant.
