Dear Parents:

Wednesday, October 13 is the date that the PSAT/NMSQT test will be given to all 11th graders and any 10th graders that wish to take it. The testing will take place at our school during school hours. This test is a multiple-choice test which measures certain developed verbal, mathematical, and writing abilities. The initials stand for the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test.

All juniors are required to take this test even if they do not see college in their future. It will be good practice for the SAT test that many will take next spring. Also, the results will show them their strengths and weaknesses in areas associated with success on a college level. Sophomores are invited to take the test to familiarize them with this type of test. The students have been given (at no charge) a study booklet.

The test results will be reported to our school in mid-December. We will then meet with the parents and students during an evening and discuss the test results. Additional individual appointments may be made to discuss the results if needed.

In order to register your student for the test, you should sign the attached form. The form, along with a \$13.00 testing fee (all of which goes to the Educational Testing Service), should be returned to the high school office no later than Friday, October 8, 2010. If you pay by check, please make the check payable to Cumberland Christian School as the Educational Testing Service does not accept personal checks. If you have any questions concerning the test, please contact me.
